Critical thinking under that name was inspired by pragmatic philosopher John Dewey (1910) and endorsed by analytic philosopher Max Black (1946). Dewey was revered by the progressive educators, who re-labeled his “ reflective thinking ” as “ critical thinking, ” a name I believe they originated and that persists to the present (see Aiken (1942) for a mixture of both terms).
