Period 1: 1450-1648 - Paul Sargent Makes History

1450 to 1648 1.1 European scholars began to gravitate toward questioning and using research to observe the natural world rather than basing it on religious beliefs and principles. European scholars began to utilize classical texts, such as Aristotle and Ptolemy, to promote learning and institute new values in society and religion.

1450 to 1648 – Modern World History

1648 marks the end of the Thirty Years' War in the Holy Roman Empire with the signing of a series of peace treaties called the Peace of Westphalia. 1648 marks the end of the Eighty Years' War between Spain and the Dutch Republic, with Spain formally recognizing the independence of the Dutch Republic.
