Freddie Mercury was rock ' s most dazzling showman, a legendary entertainer who in 1991, at the age of just forty-five, became the first major music star to die of AIDS. Mercury ' s soaring four-octave voice was a defining element in Queen ' s unique sound, crucial to the success of the band ' s fifteen studio albums, from Queen (1973) to Made in Heaven (1995). He pushed the limits of camp in everything he did. His extreme behaviour, in a society in which being gay was only starting to be accepted, just added to Freddie Mercury ' s allure.
