Linking to a SQL Server database from Access is not much different to creating a linked table to a backend Access database. SQL Server is a more robust database management system than Access. However, Access does have certain advantages over SQL Server, like being able to create forms and reports easily – even within a single click.

How to Link an Access Database to SQL Server in Access 2016

To connect to SQL Server: On the File menu, select Connect to SQL Server. If you previously connected to SQL Server, the command name will be

Connecting to SQL Server (AccessToSQL) - SQL Server ...

The easiest way to connect with SQL would be creating a DSN on the local machine and use it to link SQL tables in Access. This is also the least recommended, since you have to repeat the process for every computer using your Access with SQL database. You can also distribute a DSN file with your application as well.

SQL Server Connection Strings for Microsoft Access

Microsoft Access gives you the ability to issue the query created in Access directly against the SQL Server database, using T-SQL commands.
