**Head and neck cancer — NHS**

Cancers that are known collectively as head and neck cancers usually begin in the squamous cells that line the moist, mucosal surfaces inside the head and neck (for example, inside the mouth, the nose, and the throat). These squamous cell cancers are often referred to as squamous cell carcinomas of the head and neck.

The most common type of head and neck cancer is squamous cell carcinoma (squamous cell cancer). About 9 out of 10 head and neck cancers (90%) start in squamous cells. Squamous cells line the mouth, nose and throat. Other cell types A small number of head and neck cancers develop from other types of cells.

Head and neck cancer is a group of cancers that starts in the mouth, nose, throat, larynx, sinuses, or salivary glands. Symptoms for head and neck cancer may include a lump or sore that does not heal, a sore throat that does not go away, trouble swallowing, or a change in the voice. There may also be unusual bleeding, facial swelling, or trouble breathing.

Having a biopsy for head and neck cancer To make a diagnosis, your doctor needs to remove a small piece of tissue or some cells from the area that looks abnormal. This is called a biopsy. A doctor who specialises in analysing cells (called a pathologist) looks at the sample under the microscope.
