Some of them Geoffrey of Monmouth wrote about as early as 1136 AD in his History of the Kings of Britain , while others were popularized by Sir Thomas Mallory or even as late as Alfred, Lord Tennyson in the early 1800 ' s.

The fellowship of the Round Table, in fact, became comparable to, and in many respects the prototype of, the many great orders of chivalry that were founded in Europe during the later Middle Ages. By the late 15th century, when Sir Thomas Malory wrote his Le Morte Darthur, the notion of chivalry was inseparable from that of a great military brotherhood established in the household of some great prince.
