Switching to manual mode prevents that from happening. The advantage of manual mode is that once you have determined the optimum exposure settings, you can set the ISO, aperture and shutter speed and keep them the same until the light changes (or you want to alter them for creative reasons). Manual mode works best when the light levels are steady.

When you're shooting in changing light it's helpful to let the camera set the sensitivity value by setting it to automatic, which allows you to maintain constant aperture and shutter speed settings. When you are in manual mode on many cameras you will see the influence of your exposure settings on the monitor as you make adjustments. Essentially, all you need to do is make sure the meter is reading zero or the image is looking good on your camera monitor. You make this happen by adjusting the ISO, aperture and shutter speed controls.

6 Tips To Help You Master Manual Mode On Your Digital Camera

You could start by metering a medium-gray card, exposing per the meter reading, then shooting additional images giving more exposure and less exposure in 1/3- or 1/2-stop increments out to 4 or 5 stops beyond the initial exposure. That will give you an idea of how your camera responds to changes in exposure.

Assignment: Step by step lesson to help you fully understand manual mode exposure. Change your camera setting to manual (M) mode and turn it on. Press and hold down the exposure compensation button while turning the rotating dial until the aperture is the lowest f number it can go. You will be able to see this on the back LCD display.

Turn the camera's mode dial to Manual or Bulb shooting mode and use a slow shutter speed (5-30 seconds) for a longer exposure. The longer the exposure, the mistier the water appears. Use your camera's self-timer or a cable release to take the photo with absolutely no

blurring. Don't use flash because it could ruin the effect in the image.

Settings Your Exposure for White To set my exposure I usually just fill the frame with snow, and adjust the settings in Manual mode, until I see the caret on the camera's meter indicate that the exposure is now at +2 stops for overcast snow or +1 1/3 stops for brightly lit snow. The general process of shooting in manual mode might look something like this: Check the exposure of your shot with the light meter visible through your viewfinder. Pick an aperture. Adjust the shutter speed. Pick an ISO setting.

A good tip for those that would like to try all manual exposure is to create a spreadsheet that lists your most common light conditions, as well as apertures, ISO's and the corresponding shutter speeds. Once done, print it very small then tape it on top of your camera (the Leica M's have enough room).
