Obvious from its title, the CD features works in mainly the popular European musical genres of the 19th century such as waltzes, polka-mazurkas, schottisches and marches, some composed by Ottoman sultans like Abdulaziz (1830-76) and Murad V (1840-1904) and some by Italian music teachers employed at court in Constantinople including Callisto Guatelli Pasha and Giuseppe Donizetti Pasha, the elder brother of Gaetano Donizetti.

The introduction of Western music into Ottoman court began with Donizetti's activity as director of the Muzika-i Hümayun. The Turkish students in the Ottoman palace were taught to sing Italian songs while the court orchestra began to play selections from Italian operas.
