According to the American Nurses Association (ANA), the nursing code of ethics is a guide for “ carrying out nursing responsibilities in a manner consistent with quality in nursing care and the ethical obligations of the profession. ” Ethics, in general, are the moral principles that dictate how a person will conduct themselves.

Much attention has been paid to the role of the nurse in recognizing and addressing ethical dilemmas. There has been less emphasis, however, on the issue of whether or not nurses understand the ethical nature of everyday practice. Awareness of the inherently ethical nature of practice is a component of nurse ethical sensitivity, which has been identified as a component of ethical decision-making.

Normally, professional responsibility in nursing is assigned. This means that nurses are instructed on what roles they are to perform, what they should be in charge of, and who they should report to. Provision 5The nurse owes the same duties to self as to others, including the responsibility to promote health and safety, preserve wholeness of character and integrity, maintain competence, and continue personal and professional growth.

Professional standards define the practice and behaviour of nurses and midwives and include: codes of conduct, standards for practice, and ; codes of ethics. Codes of conduct. Please note that from 1 March 2018, professional boundaries expectations are included in the codes of conduct and are no longer separate documents.

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
